In September, you should have received an email about our new HVAC Designer Registry launching. This is a huge step for our association and the industry and we are excited to establish and promote it with support from NRCan. As we begin work on this project, we encourage all designers to apply for the registry. This registry will be promoted to municipalities as a part of our project over the next year and a half. As of May 1st, Alberta will be requiring F280 calculations and we would love to use our registry to show that there is industry capacity to accomplish this.
